

WZF CALLS FOR UNITED ACTION OF ZAKAT INSTITUTIONS WORLDWIDE TO FIGHT AGAINTS COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- 4. Exchanging information and experience in handling the Covid-19 among WZF member countries.
- 5. Providing critical assistance for those working in the informal sector of the economy which highly depends on daily income sources.
- 6. Strengthening global cooperation among WZF member countries for potential collaboration to conduct crowdfunding donation in order to help member countries facing Covid-19.
